

CHAPTER 16

OFFENSES

PENALTY FOR MISDEMEANOR

16.101. Penalty for Misdemeanor. Any person found guilty of conduct defined as a misdemeanor in any provision of this code shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine not to exceed \$900.00 or imprisonment for 90 days, or both, unless a lesser penalty is prescribed by the provision. Where any statute adopted by reference as a part of this code prescribed a lesser penalty than that prescribed herein, such lesser penalty as required by the statute shall prevail.

16.102. Penalty for Petty Misdemeanor. Any person found guilty of conduct defined as a petty misdemeanor in any provision of this code shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine not to exceed \$100.00, unless a lesser penalty is prescribed by the provision. Where any statute adopted by reference as a part of this code prescribes a lesser penalty than that prescribed herein, such lesser penalty as required by the statute shall prevail.

OFFENSES

16.201. Criminal Code of 1963 Adopted. The provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1971 Chapter 609, as amended from time to time, known as the Criminal Code of 1963, are hereby adopted as an ordinance relating to criminal offenses committed within the City, and are hereby made a part of this code as if fully set forth herein, except to the extent that the application of said statute is otherwise modified by the provision of this code.

MORALS AND CONDUCT

16.301. Destruction of Property. No person shall destroy any windows or glass or doors of any kind in any building nor shall any person break into any building, nor shall any person mutilate or deface any building occupied or unoccupied within the City.
