## **RESOLUTION NO. 2019-05**

## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A SUMMARY PUBLICATION OF ORDINANCE Chapter 19, FLOODPLAINS

WHEREAS, publication of the title summarizing Ordinance Chapter 19 will clearly inform the public of the intent and effect of the Ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, a printed copy of the text of Ordinance Chapter 19 will be available for inspection by any person during regular business hours at the Lucan City Office or by standard or electronic mail; and

WHEREAS, the ordinances shall become effective upon their passage and publication as provided by law; and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance is deemed lengthy and the City Council determines publication of a summary of the Ordinance sufficient to clearly inform the public of the intent and effect of the ordinance;

**NOWTHERE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Council hereby determines to publish the following summary language, which is hereby approved, in lieu of publishing the full ordinance amendment:

Summary: This ordinance adopts a model floodplain ordinance provided by the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources. Minnesota Statues Chapters 103F and chapter 462 delegated the authority to local governmental units to adopt regulations designed to minimize flood losses. Minnesota Statues Chapter 103F further stipulates that communities subject to recurrent flooding must participate and maintain eligibility in the National Flood insurance Program. The ordinance provides the general regulations for development in areas located in the floodplain, addresses potential conflicts with other City ordinances, delineates permitted uses, provides provision for administration of the ordinance through the issuance of land use permits and variances, regulates non-conformities and outlines penalties for violations. The ordinance also addresses the placement of travel trailers and travel vehicle and recreational vehicle in flood plain areas. The Ordinance is effective upon passage and publication of the Council approved summary.
